ORDER CONTINUING PLAINTIFFS'  
MOTION FOR SUMMARY  
JUDGMENT

This matter comes before the Court on "Plaintiffs' Motion and Memorandum in Support of Summary Judgment: Granting Specific Performance and Dismissing Amiga's Counterclaim." In response to plaintiffs' motion, Mr. Bill McEwen, the President and Chief Executive Officer of defendant Amiga, submitted a letter requesting an additional sixty days in which to respond to plaintiffs' motion, arguing that business obligations had prevented defendant from obtaining counsel to defend this litigation. Although defendant's justification for its failure to retain counsel in this matter is insufficient, the Court finds that a short delay in considering plaintiffs' motion will promote the ends of justice.

Defendant's request for an extension of time is therefore GRANTED in part.
